

A message from our CEO, Hannah Shead.....

Dear Candidate,

Thank you for your interest in this vacancy.

Trevi is a nationally award-winning women's charity based in South West England. We provide safe and nurturing spaces for women and their families to heal, grow and thrive. Our vision is for a society where all women in recovery can access good quality, psychologically informed, gender-based interventions without apology.

In the 28 years we have been operating, we have helped transform the lives of thousands of women and their children. From rehab and health to housing and employment, we help any woman in recovery move from 'surviving' to 'thriving'. The experience of the women we support informs everything we do; from the services we provide to our influencing and campaigning work.

We currently run three centres

Jasmine Mother's Recovery

Rated overall Good by CQC and Outstanding in the domains of Responsiveness and Caring, our rehab centre takes referrals from across the UK and can accommodate up to 10 women and their children at any given time.

We are a trauma informed service; as well as working with the presenting issues of substance misuse / parenting concerns, we aim to address the underlying trauma that many women have experienced. We offer EMDR, a NICE approved intervention for trauma.

The average stay is 24 weeks.

The Sunflower Women's Centre

Our Sunflower Women's Centre opened in 2016 to provide medium to long-term trauma-informed outreach support to any woman who has support needs. Sunflower is a registered training centre which runs a menu of nationally accredited therapeutic and vocational programmes which support women in addressing trauma, building resilience and progressing in all areas of their lives. Practical support includes assistance with parenting, benefits, accommodation, exercise, relationships, connecting with the community and employability. This centre also runs Pause Plymouth.



Daffodil Family Centre

Daffodil is a national parenting assessment centre which provides focused, purposeful, time limited residential assessments. The centre enables parenting capacity to be assessed whilst the child remains in the care of the parent.

Dedicated to ensuring the best outcomes for children, Daffodil places the child at the centre of its work with a trauma informed approach. The safety and welfare of the child is paramount. Whilst our assessment will consider and support the needs of the parents, the focus will be on the child, with a view to facilitate care planning for the child's longer-term future.
